2011 CENSUS BULLETIN: Language

This report summarizes language data collected during the 2011 Census for Wellington, Dufferin, and Guelph (WDG). According to the 2011 Census, there are 121,685 residents of Guelph, 86,675 residents of Wellington County (excluding Guelph), and 56,880 residents of Dufferin County, for a total of 265,240 residents in WDG. In 2011, 99% of WDG residents had some knowledge of English; less than 1% of residents had no knowledge of an official language.


