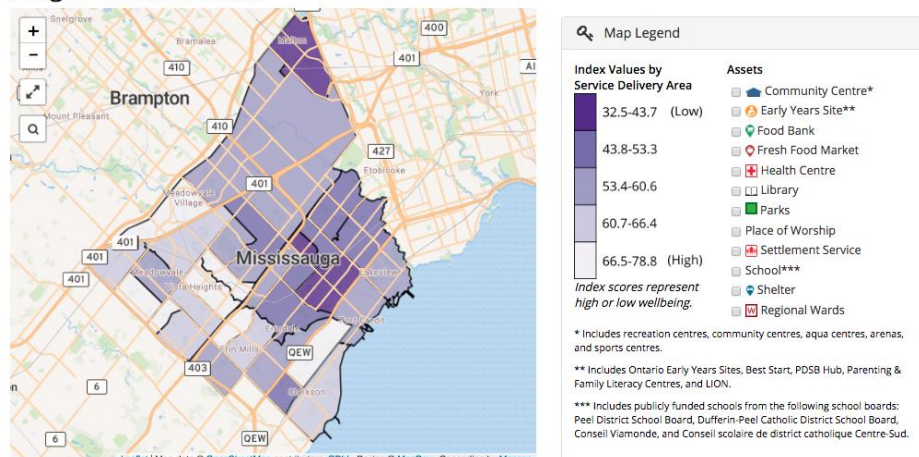
Summary

The [Neighbourhood Information Tool](#) provides an individual snapshot of neighbourhood well-being for the Region of Peel.

Peel's Neighbourhood Information Tool is an important starting point for understanding our neighbourhoods better. Having more information about our neighbourhoods helps governments, service providers, community groups and residents plan together and take action to support communities to thrive over the long term.

The Tool combines quantitative and qualitative data and maps assets across domains of neighbourhood well-being in order to provide a snapshot in time of how neighbourhoods are doing. The tool assesses Service Delivery Areas (SDA's) across 6 domains and 21 indicators, which are combined to create an index score.
